BIOGRAPHY of Dr ARIF S. YUNUSOV

Dr Arif S. Yunusov was born January 12, 1955 in Baku. In 1981 graduated from Azerbaijan State University, Historical department. He worked at the Institute of History of the Academy of Sciences till 1992. In 1986 he defended a thesis on the theme «The History of War in Azerbaijan».

In 1992 Arif S. Yunusov worked as the Chief of Information-Analytical Center of the Presidential Administration of Azerbaijan and in 1993-1994 was the president of the Analytical Center "Azeri". Since 1995 till now he heads Department of Conflict and Migration Studies of the Institute of Peace and Democracy.

Mr. Yunusov is an expert of the Independent Research Council on Migration of CIS and Baltic countries as well as international network of ethnological monitoring and early conflict prevention. He is the author of more than 220 scientific publications dedicated to the history of Azerbaijan as well as various aspects of the Karabakh conflict, problems of migrations, religion, national minorities and refugees published in Azerbaijan and outside it.

In 1997 he prepared report for the International Organization on Migration about the situation of Meskhetian Turks, in 1998-1999 on the grant received from MacArthur Foundation undertook research about the influence of Karabakh conflict on the change of life of national minorities of Azerbaijan. In 2000 owing to the Institute of the Open Society Azerbaijan he published in Russian and English languages a book "Meskhetian Turks: people twice deported". Thanks to the support of the Macarthur's Foundation in 2002 he published a book "Culture of Peace" in Azeri and Russian languages. In 2004 owing to the support of the Friedrich Ebert Foundation he published in Azeri, Russian and English languages a book "Islam in Azerbaijan". Thanks to the support of the TURAN agency in 2005 he published a book "Karabakh: Past and Present" in English language. In 2007 owing to the support of the Friedrich Ebert Foundation he published in Russian and English languages a book "Azerbaijan in the beginning of XXI Century: Conflicts and Potential Threats". In 2009 owing to the support of the Royal Norwegian Embassy he

published in Russian and English languages a book "Migration Processes in Azerbaijan".
